WHAT WE DO

Services for Survivors

When you're afraid, it can be overwhelming—even paralyzing—to take one more step, to tell one more person about what you've experienced.

One Place provides a single location for victims and survivors of domestic and sexual violence to access the services and resources they need.

At One Place, victims and survivors can

- Develop a safety plan with the support of trained professionals
- Meet with law enforcement officials to help with possible criminal charges, gather evidence and share information on how the criminal court process works
- Obtain legal services with on-site attorneys and support from legal advocates to help explain legal rights and protections and navigate the judicial system
- Undergo medical exams by a specially trained nurse to examine and expertly document injuries, including sexual assault and strangulation
- Receive emotional support, counseling and case management that can support healing from the emotional impacts of violence

Community and Systems Advocacy

Because domestic and sexual violence are complex community issues, they require complex community solutions. One Place's uniquely collaborative model enables us to address holistically the policies, processes, and systems that hinder justice and healing for survivors.
